

## Saskatchewan Angus Association Century Sweepstakes 2019

### Rules and Regulations

1. The Saskatchewan Angus Association Century Sweepstakes is open to **Canadian Calendar Year (2019 born) Red Angus & Black Angus Bull Calves which must be halter broke. Black – Red Carrier Calendar Year Bull Calves are also eligible and will show in the Red Angus division.**
2. The Saskatchewan Angus Association Century Sweepstakes will be held on Thursday, December 12, 2019 at Prairieland Park in conjunction with the Masterpiece Sale in Saskatoon, SK.
3. Check in time for the Saskatchewan Angus Association Century Sweepstakes is 5:00 pm on December 11, 2019. All bulls must be onsite prior to that.
4. All entries to the Saskatchewan Angus Association Century Sweepstakes must have an Angus RFID tag and be registered with the Canadian Angus Association by no later than December 1, 2019 to be eligible to compete. Bulls must be parent verified by check in time in order to compete in sweepstakes. You must also notify the Saskatchewan Angus Association of the tattoo and name of the bulls you will be bringing to the Sweepstakes by December 1, 2019.
5. A membership for the Saskatchewan Angus Association Century Sweepstakes is \$1,050. This entitles you to one vote in all classes pertaining to their designated colour (Red Angus or Black Angus) competing in the Saskatchewan Angus Association Century sweepstakes. A bull calf entry is \$525 for one bull and \$1,050 for multiple bulls with no limit to the number of bulls you can bring. Bull entries received after October 15, 2019 are double. You must have a membership in order to enter a bull. Individuals are only allowed to hold one voting membership per colour (Red Angus or Black Angus in the Saskatchewan Angus Association Century Sweepstakes. (All fees include GST)
6. Voting memberships and bull entries that have been received and paid for by October 15, 2019 will be eligible for an Early Bird Draw to be held at Lloydminster Stockade Roundup during the Angus Gold Show.
7. Voting Memberships purchased after the early bird deadline of October 15, 2019 will remain at \$1,050 and can be purchased until one hour prior to the commencement of the show on December 12, 2019.
8. Herd Entry Fees received after the Early Bird Deadline of October 15, 2019 will be \$2,100 for a single bull entry (\$1,050 voting membership + \$1,050 entry fee) and \$3,150 for a multiple bull entry (\$1,050 voting membership + \$2,100 entry fee). Late entries close on December 1, 2019. (All fees include GST)
9. Information for all bulls entered in the Saskatchewan Angus Association Century Sweepstakes must be received by December 1, 2019.

10. If an individual wishes to participate in judging the event without exhibiting any bulls, they can purchase a voting membership for a fee of \$1,050. This will allow the individual one membership and one vote in all classes pertaining to their designated colour (Red Angus or Black Angus) competing in the Saskatchewan Angus Association Century Sweepstakes and receive all privileges in the event including 10 straws of semen on the Champion Red Angus or Champion Black Angus bull. Each individual must be in-person to be allowed to vote in the event. Proxy votes are not allowed. Only one person per Saskatchewan Angus Association Century Sweepstakes membership will be allowed in the ring at time of judging.
11. Partnership bull calves are eligible to be entered in the Saskatchewan Angus Association Century Sweepstakes only if all co-owners of the bull calf in question purchase individual voting memberships. The co-owned bull calf can be included as a multiple bull calf of any of the co-owners as per above. Details of co-ownership must be submitted to the Saskatchewan Angus Association by December 1, 2019 or any potential prize money will be paid to the entrant of the bull calf.
12. Calendar year bull calves entered in the Saskatchewan Angus Association Century Sweepstakes will compete to win prize money awarded as follows: **Champion Red Angus Bull up to \$50,000 & Champion Black Angus Bull up to \$50,000**. The prize will be awarded to the selected bull's exhibitors once sufficient qualified, acceptable semen is successfully frozen on the bulls. The winning members will have until May 15, 2020 to produce viable frozen semen or the prize money will be forfeited. All semen will be collected at a collection facility designated by the Saskatchewan Angus Association. The owners of the Champion bulls agree to relinquish 3/4 interest and full possession of chosen bulls in exchange for the sweepstakes title and prize money.
13. Each membership in the Saskatchewan Angus Association Century Sweepstakes will receive 10 straws of semen from either the Champion Red Angus Bull or the Champion Black Angus Bull. In the unlikely event the Saskatchewan Angus Association Century Sweepstakes Champions do not produce acceptable semen in the time frame allotted, the Saskatchewan Angus Association will refund 100% of the voting memberships to each membership holder of their designated color by July 1, 2020. Bull entry fees will not be refunded.
14. A ¼ Semen Interest will remain with the original owner/exhibitor of the Saskatchewan Angus Association Century Sweepstakes Champion Red Angus Bull and Champion Black Angus Bull. The Saskatchewan Angus Association will sell ¾ interest and full possession of the Saskatchewan Angus Association Century Sweepstakes Champion Red Angus Bull and Champion Black Angus bull in the Masterpiece Sale on December 12, 2019 in Saskatoon, SK. The sale will be pending the champion bulls' fulfillment of their semen collection commitment.
15. 100% of the pending sale will be the property of and paid to the Saskatchewan Angus Association. 50% will be due sale day with the balance due prior to the purchaser assuming possession of either the bull or his semen.

16. By entering a bull into the Saskatchewan Angus Association Century Sweepstakes, the exhibitor agrees if his/her bull is selected as Champion Red Angus Bull or Champion Black Angus Bull to not market any semen in 2019 and 2020 in Canada. Semen may be drawn for use by the original owners of the bulls and the purchasers of  $\frac{3}{4}$  interest and possession lots at the Masterpiece Sale 2019. However, no sales or gifts of such semen will be allowed from the original owners or the  $\frac{3}{4}$  interest and full possession lot purchasers without risk of forfeiture of the prize amount in Canada. International semen sales (including any country other than Canada) are not restricted in any way.
17. Saskatchewan Angus Association Century Sweepstakes Members may re-sell or gift their 10 straws of semen in 2019 or 2020 only to other Century Sweepstakes Members.
18. Costs to collect the semen for the Saskatchewan Angus Association Century Sweepstakes will be covered by the Saskatchewan Angus Association and/or its sponsors. Any additional semen drawn for the original owners or the purchasers of the  $\frac{3}{4}$  interest and full possession lots will be the responsibility of said parties. Storage of that semen and shipping and handling charges become the responsibility of the member once the semen has been collected and frozen.
19. Based on the number of bulls entered, the Saskatchewan Angus Association will decide on the exact format to determine Saskatchewan Angus Association Century Sweepstakes Champion Red Angus and Champion Black Angus Bull.
20. Voting memberships will be capped at 100 memberships. 100% of the proceeds from memberships collected will be divided and paid out to the Champion bulls.
21. The Saskatchewan Angus Association board of directors will interpret all rules above and holds the right to refuse any entry which does not meet the qualifications, rules and regulations set out in this document.
22. The Saskatchewan Angus Association is not responsible for any loss associated with the Saskatchewan Angus Association Century Sweepstakes and is simply acting as a third party in hosting this event.
